Project Story

Wakefield wanted to work with a company that not only provided the best design but also gave great consideration to providing good access and inclusivity to all items of equipment.

The design principle for this project has been to provide an attractive area with a range of exciting fixed play equipment that encourages children to be imaginative, challenging and creative. Natural elements such as boulders, grass mounds and shingle based central seating area have been included. Two main areas in the park were created, one specifically aimed at toddlers and one towards teenagers. Linking these two areas is the central seating area where parents can socialise whilst watching their children have fun. Proludic have incorporated elements that allow young children to explore their environment at different levels, encouraging imaginative play experiences. While the teen area is dynamic, challenging and robust.

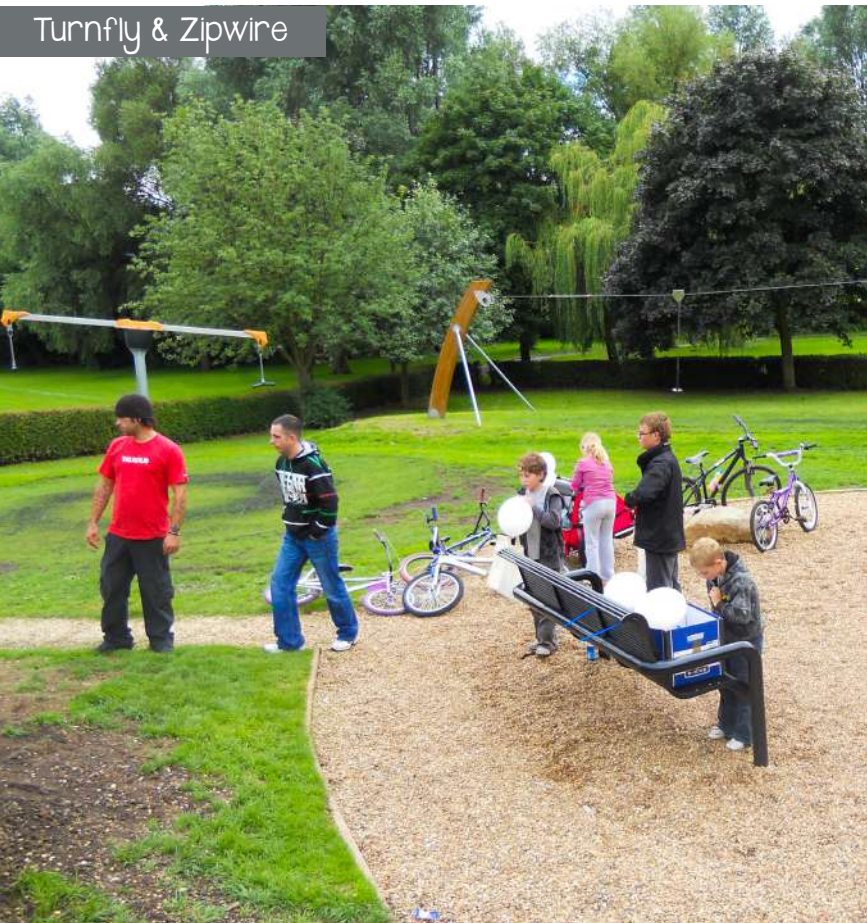
