Local Equipped Area of Play (LEAP) -

Key Features:

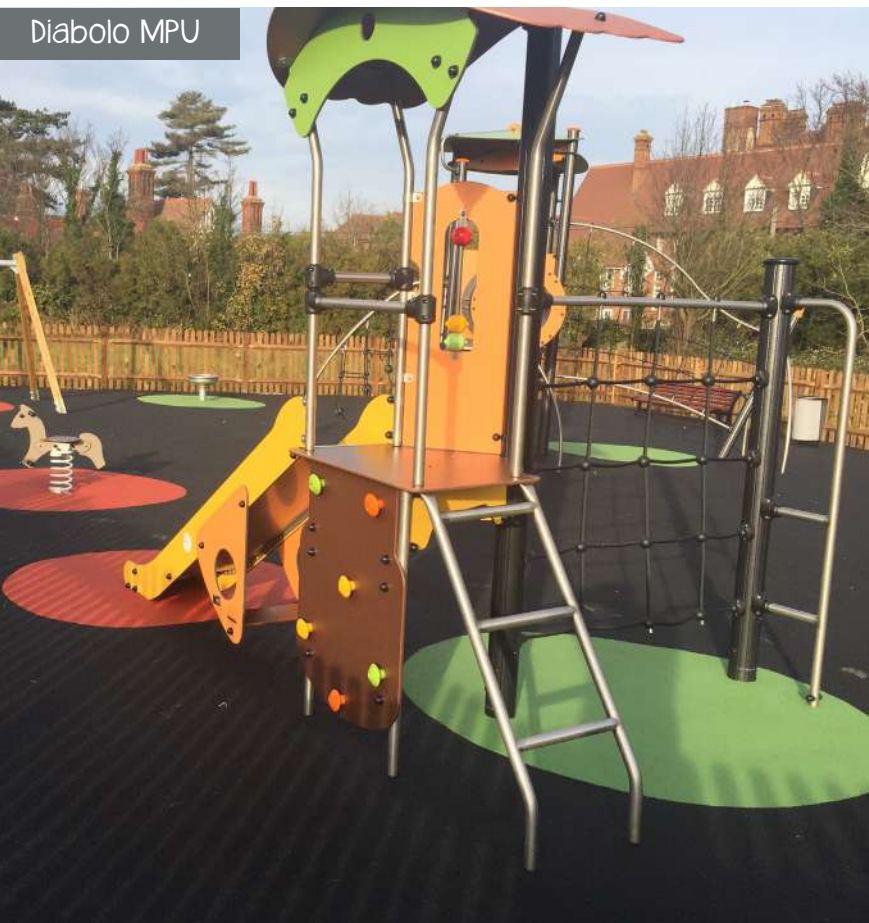
- . Its primary function is to engage local children and encourage growth/independency
 - . It is within a 5-minute walking distance from the child's house
 - . 20 meters minimum separation between activity zone and the boundary of dwellings
 - . They are best positioned by a pedestrian route that is well used, although this is not mandatory.
- They must occupy an area of flat grass or hard surface which is well drained together with impact absorbing surfaces beneath and around play equipment or structures as appropriate. The recommended minimum activity zone is 400 square metres with 5+ play activities



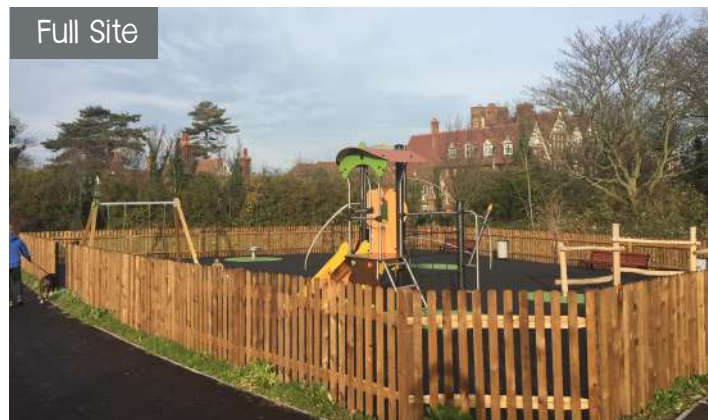
Bibox MPU
