- . A small area of open space specifically designated for young children, although it can be used at different times of day (i.e. evening) by older children.
- . It should be within a minute walking distance from the child's house.
- . Best positioned by a pedestrian route that is well used.
- . The recommended minimum activity zone is 100 square meters.
